New Initiative taken by NDC

1. National Documentation Centre (NDC), NIHFW had conducted a workshop to set up a Public Health Consortium (P-HELCON) with the members of CTIs Library for the purpose of sharing and dissemination of information to the member's institutions and other organizations.
2. Proposal for Digitization of theses has been conceived as a move to increase its relevance in this contemporary era of information communication technology.
3. Proposal for Radio Frequency Identification (RFID) System in NDC has been initiated to automate business processes and allows identification of large number of tagged objects like books, using radio waves.
